

ORDINANCE 123-06

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 15, MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF MODENA REGARDING STOP INTERSECTIONS, TRUCKS PROHIBITED ON CERTAIN STREETS/EXCEPTIONS, PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES IN CERTAIN LOCATIONS, GENERAL PARKING RULES, AND CERTAIN STREETS DESIGNATED FOR SNOW REMOVAL.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Modena, Chester County, Pennsylvania, that certain provisions of Chapter 15, Motor Vehicles and Traffic, of the Code of the Borough of Modena, as amended, be further amended as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 15, Motor Vehicles and Traffic, Part 2, Traffic Regulations, §15-205, Stop Intersections, is hereby amended in its entirety to designate the following intersections as stop intersections and authorize the installation of stop signs at the following locations:

Stop Street	Through Street	Direction of Travel
Baker Street	North Brandywine Avenue	East
Belmar Street	Baker Street	North
Mary Street	Baker Street	North
Johnson Street	Baker Street	North
Fulton Street	Baker Street	North
Fulton Street	Mary Street	South
Filbert Street	Baker Street	North
Woodland Avenue	North Brandywine Avenue	East and West
North Brandywine Avenue	Woodland Avenue	North and South
South Brandywine Avenue	Hephzibah Hill Road	North
Lloyd Street	North Brandywine Avenue	East
Meredith Court	Union Street	South

SECTION 2. Chapter 15, Motor Vehicles and Traffic, Part 2, Traffic Regulations, §15-212, Trucks Prohibited on Certain Streets/Exceptions, is hereby amended in its entirety to designate the following streets as streets upon which operation of any truck is prohibited:

Street	Between
North Brandywine Avenue	Union Street and Borough Line
Woodland Avenue	Brandywine Avenue and Borough Line

SECTION 3. Chapter 15, Motor Vehicles and Traffic, Part 3, General Parking Regulations, §15-305, Parking Prohibited at All Times in Certain Locations, is hereby amended in its entirety to designate the following streets as streets upon which parking is prohibited at all times:

Street	Side	Between
Baker Street	Both	Entire Length
North Brandywine Avenue	Both	Entire Length
South Brandywine Avenue	Both	Entire Length
Meredith Court	West	Entire Length
Woodland Avenue	Both	Entire Length

SECTION 4. Chapter 15, Motor Vehicles and Traffic, Part 3, General Parking Regulations, §15-313, General Parking Rules, Subparagraph 1, Subsection L is hereby amended to state as follows:

- L. Within 20 feet of a driveway entrance to any fire department station and on the side of the street opposite the entrance to any such station within 75 feet of such entrance; any such vehicle will be subject to immediate towing at the owner's expense.

SECTION 5. Chapter 15, Motor Vehicles and Traffic, Part 3, General Parking Regulations, §15-313, General Parking Rules, Subparagraph 2 is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

- 2. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this Section shall be fined, together with cost of prosecution, as follows:
 - A. Fifty dollars (\$50.00) for those violations in §15-313.1.A through §15-313.1.H.
 - B. One Hundred and Fifty dollars (\$150.00) for those violations in §15-313.1.I through §15-313.1.L.
 - C. Fifteen dollars (\$15.00) for violations in §15-313.1.M.
 - D. Fifty dollars (\$50.00) for violations in §15-313.1.N.

SECTION 6. Chapter 15, Motor Vehicles and Traffic, Part 6, Snow and Ice Emergency, §15-604, Certain Streets Designated for Snow Removal, is hereby amended in its entirety to designate the following streets for snow removal or plowing:

Street	Between
Baker Street	Entire Length
North Brandywine Avenue	Entire Length
South Brandywine Avenue	Entire Length
Mary Street	Entire Length
Woodland Avenue	Entire Length

SECTION 7. Chapter 15, Motor Vehicles and Traffic, Part 6, Snow and Ice Emergency, §15-607, Penalties, is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

1. During such time as a snow removal condition is in effect, any person who shall park a vehicle anywhere upon or along any of the streets of the Borough that have been publicly designated for snow removal or plowing shall be towed and shall be guilty of a violation of this Part and, upon conviction thereof, shall be sentenced to pay a fine of \$50.00 plus costs of prosecution.
2. Any person who shall operate a vehicle upon any street of the Borough, if such vehicle shall become stalled during such time as a snow removal condition is in effect, and if such stalling shall have been by reason of the failure to have such vehicle equipped as prescribed in §15-605 of this Part, shall be guilty of a violation of this Part and, upon conviction thereof, shall be sentenced to pay a fine of \$50.00 plus costs of prosecution.

SECTION 8. If any sentence, clause or section or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or validity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Borough of Modena Council that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal, invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.


SECTION 9. All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting or inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
