

**Resolution #328-2023**  
**2023 CRP Grant for additional funding from the Chester County**  
**Department of Community Development Grant Program**  
**for Modena Borough**

**BE IT RESOLVED** that the Borough of Modena, PA, is in need of repairs to its roads and it has been determined that because of age and deficiency, the roads of Baker St., North Brandywine Ave., and Woodland Ave., need significant repair. Along with road repair, storm water management needs to be improved, added and corrected along the above-mentioned street within the Borough. This is to be accomplished with the addition, repair and improvements of storm water, drains, inlets, drainpipes and proper engineering. Along with the repair of said roads, traffic-calming measures are to be installed in an effort to reduce the speed of vehicles along North Brandywine Ave. for the safety of motorists, cyclists and pedestrians. Installation of roadway marking and signage should be installed as well for safety measures. Along with needed repairs, proper connections are to be made with current roadways, driveways and to create a new tie-in on North Brandywine Ave. to the new park know as Mode Park.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the Borough of Modena, PA is in need of financing for the project and is eligible for funding from the Chester County Department of Community Development Grant Program. Therefore, the Borough needs to submit an application to the Chester County Department of Community Development office to request assistance with this funding.


